



**LAY ECCLESIAL MINISTRY
CERTIFICATE PROGRAM
Diocese of Great Falls-Billings
& University of Great Falls**



The University of Great Falls in collaboration with the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings offers a **Lay Ecclesial Ministry Certificate Program** through distance learning. Initiated in the Fall of 1999, this certification program consists of 30 hours of college-level course work in theology, scripture and ministry offered through video and the internet. Lay ministry students may begin the program at any time taking either one or two classes each semester. Exceptions are that ministry courses should be taken sequentially with TLM 370 and TLM 496 following the majority of the theology courses. The *O'Hara McBride Ely Scholarship*, given by the college to Diocesan Lay Ministry students, provides a significant tuition reduction.

Application, registration, and payment for the Lay Ecclesial Ministry Certificate Program are must be sent to the Office of Lay Ministry of the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings.

Application and registration for the Fall Session beginning September 2010 are due in the Office of Lay Ministry by August 20, 2010. The scholarship will not apply if you register directly with the University.

Fees for the semester beginning Fall 2010 are:

\$35.00 application fee (one-time-only fee; not applicable if previously attended UGF)
\$777.33 includes general fee, technology fee, and three-hour credit course
(through the *O'Hara McBride Ely Scholarship* offered to Diocesan participants)

Books can be purchased through and paid directly to the UGF bookstore, Amazon.com or elsewhere. (UGF may have used books at a lower cost.)

Application/registration for the Spring semester is due in the Office of Lay Ministry by August 20, 2010. **Withdrawal from the course after the first class is subject to a fee assessment by UGF.**
